



Masaryk Memorial Cancer Institute (MMCI) in Brno is a specialized healthcare center which performs up-to-date medical procedures. We treat over 80,000 patients every year.

CENTERS FOR DIAGNOSTICS AND TREATMENT

In 2020, more than **28,000** patients were treated and underwent follow-up by our specialists.

HOSPITALIZATION

We provide over **10,000** hospitalizations every year.

SECOND OPINION

Do you need consultation on treatment held elsewhere? In MMCI, we have 10 specialized indication boards consisting of top experts. We offer medical Second opinion service, which includes consultation on treatment processes and procedures.

OUTPATIENT PROCEDURES

We perform over 250,000 outpatient procedures every year.

SURGERY

We perform 5000 surgeries every year, out of which 300 are robotic.

RADIATION

We irradiate over 5000 patients every year, including several dozens of children.

CHEMOTHERAPY

We administer more than 40,000 doses of chemotherapy every year.

CLINICAL TRIALS

We are leading nearly 100 clinical trials.

Care and Services

Care for patients and their loved ones is not only about modern equipment, state of art procedures and top-class professionals. An overall care for the patient is also a key part of the treatment.

In MMCI, we offer top care in the fields of nursing, social healthcare, nutrition, and psychology, as well as several additional services, which are aimed to elevate the quality of life during the fight against cancer. Those services help improving the course of care and the healing process.

Nursing care

In MMCI, we provide high-quality nursing care. This care is patient- and caregiver oriented. Our non-medical healthcare professionals are members of multidisciplinary teams in individual areas of care for our patients. This group includes such teams as prevention of pressure sores, long-healing wound management, post-operative wound management, care for patients with stoma and catheters. Our priority is to respect human dignity, ensure privacy and assure patient safety.

Nutrition care

Nutritional therapists in MMCI provide advice to patients during oncologic illness and cancer care. Nutrition is very important during anti-cancer treatment, and it is one of the parts of successful treatment. Proper nutrition, which ensures good nutritional state of the patient, supports the treatment, reduces side effects, accelerates recovery, and has positive effect on the quality of life and the outcome of the treatment.

Psychologic care

Oncologic patients and their loved ones go through psychologic changes and stress - this is quite normal in such situation. Nevertheless, psychologic condition of the patient could affect the treatment. Thus, our team of psychologists is ready to support the patient and his/her caregivers in case of need.

Hospital ombudsman

The hospital ombudsman provides assistance to patients, their relatives and loved ones in resolving situations related to treatment and stay at the MMCI. The ombudsman investigates complaints and suggestions on quality of provided care, operational and organizational problems, and suspicions of unethical behavior of employees of the Masaryk Memorial Cancer Institute.

Spiritual services

Foreign nationals and self-payers

As a rule in oncology, the earlier a cancer is detected, the better are treatment results and the lower is overall treatment complexity.

First stages of cancer are usually curable.

We should always monitor our health, so that we could detect a pre-tumor condition or malignant tumor at the time when it does not cause any problems yet. This is exactly the purpose of Preventive check-ups and Oncologic screening.

You should care for your body in the same way as you care for your own property.

Information for foreign nationals and self-payers

If you are a foreigner or you do not have Czech public health insurance, we will agree with you on method of payment for services provided by the Masaryk Oncology Institute (hereinafter referred to as the MMCI), arrange a visit to MMCI doctor and provide you the needed assistance with all the necessary administration related to your treatment in our medical facility.

How to do it?

- ① If you want to schedule an appointment at the outpatient clinic at MMCI, please, contact a doctor at our **Consultation outpatients department** (T +420 543 135 809). The doctor will help you to arrange an appointment for your examination at MMCI.

- ② When arriving at MMCI, please, register at the **Central Patient Evidence**, which is found at **Švejška Pavillon** (in Czech: Švejdův pavilon) on the **second floor**.
- ③ After that, you will be referred to the **Insurance Companies office** (in Czech: Úsek zdravotních pojišťoven), which is found at the **underground floor of Masaryk hall** (in Czech: Masarykův pavilon). The office is located behind the cash desk and under the headquarters.
- ④ The Insurance Company office will present you with the **Contract for Payment for Care** and agree on **means of payment**.
- ⑤ The payment can be done by several methods; **we accept both cash and credit cards**. Upon agreement, payment could be done also by wire transfer to our bank account.

If you are an EU citizen and you have a valid European healthcare insurance document or a similar document, or an S2 document proving approval of requested care, do not forget to bring these documents with you to the Health Insurance office.

Treatment costs can be covered by insurance in your home country or in the country of your health insurance.

If you are a foreigner but have Czech national health insurance, then same rules apply on you as on Czech insured persons.
